- Be hungry for God
 - Do not settle for less than God has for you
 - Jacob was in a place of brokenness that God was the only one who could help him
- Be broken by God
 - We need to be willing to be broken or changed to our betterment and God's glory
- Be honest with God
 - It is for our benefit, not God's benefit
 - Stop pretending
